#### Sean Ashby, House District 50

1. Assuming you are elected to the Florida legislature, what will be your primary area of interest and what do you hope to accomplish in this area? What committees will you request?

Trained Workforce: Implement skills training based continuing education programs

Clean Water: Not just clean water in the lagoon we see, but also the water we drink by ensuring we do not pollute by fracking and ensuring we do not over stress the Florida aquafer.

Roads/Infrastructure: Work directly with the Brevard BCC and Congressional Delegation to ensure funding is provided to repair or replace Brevard's strained and soon to be failing infrastructure.

4. The Indian River Lagoon is on the forefront of everyones mind. The fish kill began just days after Gov. Scott vetoed \$700,000 for the Indian River Lagoon project. Knowing how important Agriculture/Water issues to Brevard voters, what problems do you see & how do you intend to help overcome them?

The problems like the possible solutions are numerous. We must take a science based approach as we look to the future success of the lagoon. However, I also do feel that Brevard should implement the option of the TDT 1% increase and applied to lagoon cleanup.
